

DRM portfolio and relevant changes to DRM support strategy

In 2020, Sweden's DRM portfolio grew in size, consisting of a few larger programs and several relatively smaller programs. Variation in Sweden's DRM portfolio can be attributed to their work in conflict affected environments, or in areas where there is political tension.

Support to country-owned tax reforms

Swedish DRM support is targeted towards strengthening a country's administrative capacity and ability to plan, formulate, and implement reforms, thereby promoting country ownership of tax reforms. Bilateral development cooperation is based on bilateral strategies development in participatory processes, and based on recipient country priorities.

- Sweden has in force and is r1: compliant with the Amended Multilateral Convention on Mutual Administrative Assistance in Tax Matters for EoIR.
